




Failure to follow these instructions may result in personal or property injury, as well as reduced battery life or failure.

- Discontinue use of the unit if it emits an odor, starts producing excessive heat, or if the unit becomes distorted or warped in any way.
- The light contains toxic, flammable battery electrolytes. Opening/piercing the unit may result in injury, fire, or permanent damage to the light/other objects around it.
- Do not look directly into the light.
- The battery inside the unit will naturally discharge over time when not in use. Before use, it is recommended to charge the battery to 100%.



LIGHT FUNCTION OVERVIEW



Double press the power button to turn the light on. The light will remember the last light setting that was used. Press the power button shortly after the light is turned on to cycle through the different brightness modes. If the button is not pressed for more than 5 seconds, the next press will turn the light off.

Press the colour temperature button to cycle through the different colour temperature modes.

Double-press the orange light button to turn on the orange light and press again to cycle to strobing, and off.

POWER FUNCTION OVERVIEW

This product has a built-in 13,500mAh lithium battery which can be used to charge devices like mobile phones or portable

The USB-C port functions as a dedicated input to charge the power bank, while the USB-A port functions as a dedicated output and will charge the connected device as soon as it has been plugged in.

Please note: the USB ports cannot be used for purposes other than intended. Doing so may risk damaging the product or connected devices.

The unit uses an LED indicator to display key information about the life of the battery. The charge indicator will come on when the light has a connected input/output from one of the USB ports, or when the light is on. The battery status is indicated below:

WARRANTY



Consumer Law. You are entitled to a replacement or refund for a major failure and compensation for any other reasonably foreseeable loss or damage. You are also entitled to have the goods repaired or replaced if the goods fail to be of acceptable quality and the failure does not amount to a major failure

Hardkorr warrants that this product will be free from defects in material and workmanship for two years. The warranty commences on the date of purchase by the original purchaser, and is not transferable. To access the benefits of this warranty, you must retain your proof of purchase and follow any other direction we reasonably give you (e.g. completing and returning your warranty card if applicable).

If you believe your Hardkorr product is defective, it must be returned to Hardkorr for inspection by our warranty claims department.

TO BEGIN A WARRANTY CLAIM

- You must have a Return Authorisation (RA) number. To get your RA number, please complete the form found on our website and wait for the warranty team $% \left(1\right) =\left(1\right) \left(1$ to contact you.
- Once you have an RA number, you must arrange for the product must be shipped at your own expense back to Hardkorr (keep your receipt). The address for shipment will be provided when we issue your RA number.
- Please be sure that your RA number is clearly marked on the outside of the

Completing the steps as mentioned will ensure a faster process of your claim, so that Hardkorr can get your product back to you as soon as possible

Once we receive your returned product, our technicians will inspect it. We will then notify you of the outcome of your claim.

If we accept your warranty claim, we will either repair, replace or refund the goods at our discretion. We will also reimburse you for the shipping costs you incurred in sending the goods back to us. Any products that we choose to replace or refund become the property of Hardkorr.

If we do not accept your claim, we will advise you of the reason and hold your product for collection. You will need to arrange and pay for the product to be shipped back to you. If your product is not collected within 30 days of your warranty claim being finalised, we may destroy it.

Your warranty is voided if we (at our sole discretion) determine that there is evidence of one or more of the following:

Negligence: Improper installation, improper or extreme use, use that contravenes this

Abuse: Road hazards, Damage beyond the limits of "normal wear and tear." Unauthorised Repair: Repair service performed by an unauthorised service centre.

Disassembly: Any attempt to open, tamper with or otherwise compromise the integrity

Consequential damage: Damage to this product caused by the failure of another nent of the vehicle or device in which this product is installed.


DISCONTINUED ITEMS

Discontinued items that are still under warranty will be reviewed by Hardkorr. If a discontinued item is covered under warranty it may be replaced by an equivalent or superior item. If an equivalent item is not available Hardkorr will determine terms of resolution on a case-by-case basis.

REDUCE BUG ACTIVITY BY UP TO 90%

Bugs are attracted to light, and especially to white light. This phenomenon is called positive phototaxis. Entomologists still don't have a complete understanding of why this phenomenon exists, but it is clearly observable in nature.

Thankfully, there are some wavelengths of light that bugs can't see, but humans can. Humans can generally see light which has a wavelength between 380nm (blue) and 740nm (red). Most bugs, conversely, can see light with a wavelength between 300nm and 600nm.



Our orange camp lights are designed to sit just outside the visible spectrum for most bugs, at about 610nm. If you use orange camp lights, you will notice up to 90% fewer bugs in the vicinity compared to white light, and you can enjoy a nice fire-like glow that won't ruin your vibe.
